We opened talks with Caterpillar on January 4th, by the time you read this we will have met for


about a month. Hopefully things go well toward resolving an agreement. Both sides have agreed to a media blackout. We will update the membership on how things are going so please attend the meetings.

BARGAINING CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

DAVE NEULINGER ————

I hope everyone had a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

We have 8 discharges, 5 suspensions and 8 issue grievances in the backlog as of right now there is no arbitration scheduled until we get a contract.

Tech Center is going to start rolling TLO's. East Peoria has been recalling employees back because of 120 tractor orders. Most of the employees recalled are welders and assemblers.

On January 4, 2017 we open talks with the company and on January 18, 2017 we will open local talks, then in February we will start meeting with the Central Committee Policy until we get a contract. If you don't have your email up to date with the Union Hall, please call and update it, this is how we will be communicating through negotiations.

On February 2, 2017 we will be having a Strike Authorization vote from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the Union Hall.

It is very important that the membership stands together through negotiations.

INSURANCE & BENEFITS REPORT

TOMMY RODTS —

VSP, effective 1/1/17, is now our provider for eye insurance. All bargaining unit benefits stay the same. When using an approved provider, members should have to do nothing except pay out-of-pocket costs involved with your visit. A claim form will probably be required for all other vision providers. You can contact VSP at 1-800-877-7195 or online at vsp.com.

Social Security is receiving a cost of living allowance of .3%. Cost for Medicare Part B is going up \$12.20 to \$134.00. We are currently trying to negotiate an increase on the reimbursement from Caterpillar.

We are also currently trying to negotiate a decrease in premium costs of all people retiring after 2011 since they received a very large increase in premium costs.

If you or your spouse are medicare age, 65, and enrolled for Medicare Part A & B, you are also eligible for reimbursement of the Part B Premium. The **Plan will reimburse your premium up to \$99.50**. You must contact Hewitt at 1-877-228-4010 to enroll for the reimbursement, both the member and spouse are eligible.
