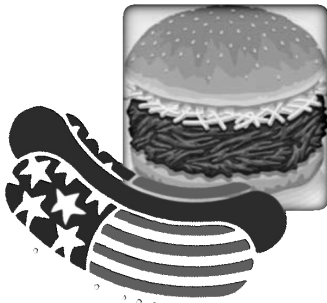

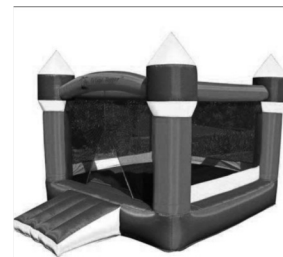

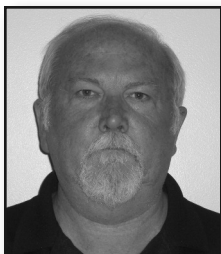

## INSURANCE AND BENEFITS REPORT BY JOHN ARNOLD

I hope everyone had a fun and safe 4th of July. First thing, I want to start off by reminding those that retired on or after April 1, 2011 that now is the time to complete the second Health Risk Assessment Survey of the year. This goes for all active members as well.

Second is the letter that some of you have received concerning your premium. If you are retired and yourself or one of your dependents are on Medicare Part B due to a disability and are younger than 65, Caterpillar has been charging you the wrong premium. Your August pension check will reflect the new premium that you will be charged for the rest of the year. If you retired before April 1, 2011, you will unfortunately see an increase in the amount you will pay. For those that retired April 1, 2011 and after, you will see a decrease.

The third thing I want to talk about is just a reminder that Annual Enrollment is just around the corner. As always, it will be in November but with only one more paper before it starts, I wanted to make sure and remind people that it is coming. Also, no, I don't know what the premium amount will be for 2017.
