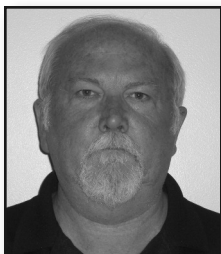

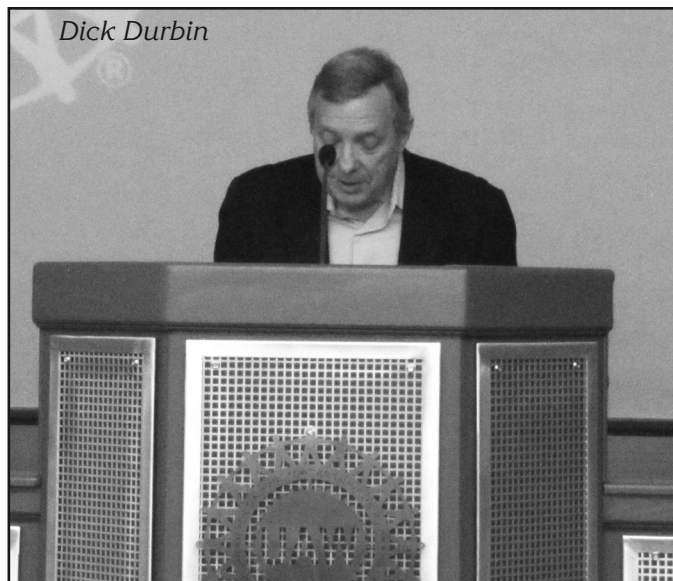
The guest speakers were U.S. Senator Dick Durbin, U.S. Representative Cheri Bustos and Senate candidate Tammy Duckworth.
