## **INSURANCE & BENEFITS REPORT**

JOHN ARNOLD ————

Well here we are again. I Want to thank everyone that came out and voted during the triennial election. It was one of the best turn outs I have ever seen. Summer is upon us finally and I hope everyone is having a safe and happy summer. It is time to complete the third quarter Health Risk Assessment and the good thing about this one is it is our last one we'll have to complete. It must be completed by September 30th. Since we will be under the management insurance plan we no longer will be required to do these surveys as of January 1, 2018.

As I write this article there has been no news as of yet on any changes to the retiree's insurance plan for next year. Nor has there been any information about what the premiums will be for 2018. I probably will not have that information until late October or early November.

If you are an active member and are on workers compensation, short term or long term medical please DO NOT do anything that is not within your restrictions. I also can't stress enough to stay off social media and posting what you are doing. The company does monitor those sites and what you post can and does impact your status and possibly any settlement offer you may be entitled to. So please stay off those sites.

As we get closer to November and the enrollment period please call ahead to make sure that someone will be here so your issue can be fully addressed. Also, this office is still encountering retirees and their spouses that have not signed up for Medicare reimbursement. If you or your spouse is on Medicare Part B and on Caterpillar insurance then you are entitled to the Medicare reimbursement. You must call Hewitt at 1-877-228-4010 to sign up. This is not done automatically.

#### **RETIREES • Medicare Reimbursement**

From time to time, I remind our retirees about the Medicare Part B reimbursement portion of our plan. If you or your spouse are medicare age, 65, and enrolled for Medicare Part A & B, you are also eligible for reimbursement of the Part B Premium. The **Plan will reimburse your premium up to \$99.50**. You must contact Hewitt at 1-877-228-4010 to enroll for the reimbursement, both the member and spouse are eligible.
