INSURANCE & BENEFITS REPORT

JOHN ARNOLD ————

Well here we are just a few weeks away from Christmas. I hope everyone had a great Thanksgiving. By the time this article gets to you Annual Enrollment will have ended for the majority of you. Only the retirees that stayed in the Union RGIP Plan for 2018 have until December 14th to make their election for Annual Enrollment. For those that have chosen to stay with the Union RgIP Plan for 2019 I have included your premiums for the next year within this paper. For those that went in the Management Plan for 2019 and are younger than 65 your premiums are in the paper as well. Everyone's premiums went up except for those that stayed on the Union RGIP Plan and are 65 and older. Your premiums went down \$13.09 per person.

There were a lot of people that got phone calls from VIA in September telling them that their Caterpillar insurance was going away at the end of the year. This was a scare tactic to get the retirees that stayed on the Union RGIP insurance for 2018 to switch to the Management Plan. At NO time was anyone's insurance that stayed on the Union RGIP Plan going away for 2019. You had to make the call yourself and get the opt-in form to switch to the Management Plan for 2019. If you did nothing you would stay on the Union RGIP insurance for 2019.

One last thing about the insurance. Our prescription drug insurer is changing from Optum RX to Magellan RX. We will be mailed new prescription drug cards sometime in late December or early January. So please be on the lookout for that mailing. As always if you have any questions please give my office a call and I will do my best to get you your answers.

In closing I hope that every one of you and your family have a happy and blessed Merry Christmas. Please be safe and responsible during the New Year holiday as well.

RETIREES - Medicare Reimbursement

From time to time, I remind our retirees about the Medicare Part B reimbursement portion of our plan. If you or your spouse are Medicare age, 65, and enrolled in Medicare Part A & B, you are eligible for reimbursement of the Part B Premium. The Plan will reimburse your Medicare premium up to \$99.50 per month every January and July. This only pertains to members and spouses that opted out of the management/executive plan and retired prior to March 26, 2017. You must contact Alight Solutions (Hewitt) at 1-877-228-4010 to enroll for the reimbursement. Once you're signed up, you won't have to sign-up again.

The President and I along with two committee chairmen attended the 2018 Ag Imp Conference in St. Pete, Florida on October 22nd through the 25th. The weather was nice and the conference was great. 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
