# INSURANCE & BENEFITS REPORT

Well it appears that spring is finally upon us. I hope everyone can get out and enjoy the weather and get over the winter blues. On April 24th I had the first seminar of the year to go over the new HRA for the active members that will be retiring under this contract. If you missed it, don't worry because I will be having one the fourth Tuesday of the month going forward. So that means the next one will be May 22nd at 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Please come out so you can be better informed before you retire.

I have tried to stress to everyone that I talk to that starting after January 2, 2019 the HRA amount of \$3,000 will not be guaranteed. There is a formula that will calculate how much you and your spouse will be eligible for if you retire after January 2, 2019. I have posted the chart in the benefits section on our website and I have included it with this article. Please look it over and contact me if you have any questions on what it means for you.

Don't forget that if you have any intention of retiring on or before January 1, 2019 you **MUST** fill out and return the Retirement Bonus application to HR/LR on or before August 31, 2018. If you turn in the application after August 31, 2018 you will not be able to receive the \$10,000 bonus. You can still retire but Caterpillar won't have to pay you that bonus.

As always, please call me if you have any questions about your retirement or insurance. I will do my best to get you the answers you seek.

## RETIREES – Medicare Reimbursement

From time to time, I remind our retirees about the Medicare Part B reimbursement portion of our plan. If you or your spouse are Medicare age, 65, and enrolled in Medicare Part A & B, you are eligible for reimbursement of the Part B Premium. The Plan will reimburse your Medicare premium up to \$99.50 per month every January and July. This only pertains to members and spouses that opted out of the management/executive plan and retired prior to March 26, 2017. **You must contact Alight Solutions (Hewitt) at 1-877-228-4010 to enroll for the reimbursement. Once you're signed up, you won't have to sign-up again.**

Greetings Brother and Sisters,

It has been a long winter and spring has finally gotten here. We have had a busy month at the hall that was probably discussed in the Presidents report.

We had the delegate election for the 37th Constitutional Convention that will be held in Detroit. The number of delegates we can send is determined by the number of our membership. We were allowed 5 delegates. We had 12 people put their hats in the ring. The Election Committee did a great job. They had to work around the Die Cast and Toy Sale which was held on Friday and Saturday and the election was on Sunday. The election was held for about 16 hours between setting up and counting ballots.

Stewards need to do a better job of greeting new employees coming into their areas. It used to be when we had good foremen, they would introduce the new employee to their steward. Explain to them on break time or before or after work if they are having issues about the job to talk to you not on company time. Make them feel welcome it's probably a big change walking into the facility from what they are used to.
