## **INSURANCE & BENEFITS REPORT**

JOHN ARNOLD ————

I hope everyone had a great Summer and is ready for Fall like I am? Fall is the best season because it has nice cool mornings and the temperature for the day doesn't get too high. Plus it's football season. Go Bears!!

Now onto insurance topics. The deadline has passed for active members that are eligible to retire to put their application in for the retirement bonus. I'm sure over the next several months a lot of you guys and gals will be retiring and I just want to say thank you for your service.

Annual enrollment is right around the corner and many of you should have received a letter from Caterpillar at the end of August or beginning of September. That letter only went out to the retirees that DID NOT get into the management plan for this year. For those of you who stayed with the "Union Plan" you will have another opportunity to get into the management plan for 2019. This may be your last chance to get into it. As of the writing of this article I don't know what 2019's premiums will be. I will post them on the UAW's website when I get them.

If you retired on or before January 1, 2005 you are NOT being offered this management plan again. I don't know why Caterpillar will not extend the offer to you, but maybe one day they finally will.

For those that are being offered the management plan again there has been seminars all this summer here at the hall discussing different plans. There is one final seminar on October 23rd at 10:00 a.m., 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. if you'd like to know how things will work with Medicare and the management plan. I will gladly answer any questions you have between now and enrollment about this management plan, but this is still a decision that each retiree and spouse need to make. I will give you the ins and outs of both offers but like last year I will not give a recommendation one way or the other.

But I want ALL of you who are on the Caterpillar/Union plan to prepare yourselves for premiums to be high for 2019. Like I said earlier I don't have those figures yet, probably won't until sometime in October, but I'm sure they will be going up. There were a lot of retirees that jumped into the management plan for 2018 which means the "pool" shrunk considerably.

I'm sure I will be seeing or talking to many of you in October and /or November. I hope everyone has a great Fall and since the next paper won't be out until December – Happy Thanksgiving!

#### **RETIREES - Medicare Reimbursement**

From time to time, I remind our retirees about the Medicare Part B reimbursement portion of our plan. If you or your spouse are Medicare age, 65, and enrolled in Medicare Part A & B, you are eligible for reimbursement of the Part B Premium. The Plan will reimburse your Medicare premium up to \$99.50 per month every January and July. This only pertains to members and spouses that opted out of the management/executive plan and retired prior to March 26, 2017. You must contact Alight Solutions (Hewitt) at 1-877-228-4010 to enroll for the reimbursement. Once you're signed up, you won't have to sign-up again.

## BARGAINING CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

MIKE ATKINSON -

Greetings Brother and Sisters,

August was a hot month for all of the members in the plants. It was a very busy month out at the hall as well.

August 9th & 10th we had committeemen training up in Ottawa at the Region 4 Pat Greathouse Center. This was for the Caterpillar facilities only, which included York, Pontiac, Decatur, Morton, Mapleton and all of the East Peoria facilities.

The topic was arbitration and grievance handling. It was a great presentation put on by J.C. Zimmerman and Tom Weber. It was an interactive class everyone had to participate and it was very informative. After talking with the committeemen at the end of the day all of the committeemen learned a lot about what it takes with the information needed to take a grievance in front of an arbitrator.

August 14th we had Mapleton docketing with the company dealing with just cause grievances, we had 5 grievances, 3 discharges and 2 suspensions. The union withdrew 2 discharges and settled on a 5 day suspension to repeat. The union held 1 discharge and 1 suspension.

August 16th we had another docket meeting with the company, dealing with issue grievances. We had 12 grievances from all of the local facilities.

Issue grievances: 4 written warning, 1 job fail, 1 ratification bonus, 2 overtime, 1 benefit language, 1 rewards/employee review and 2 call in pay.

Results: 4 written warning with 3 withdrawn and 1 held by the union, 2 overtime with 1 withdrawn and 1 held by the union, 1 benefits language was withdrawn, 1 ratification bonus is being held by union, 1 rewards/employee review is being held by the union and 2 call in pay are being held by the union.

So as of August 17, 2018 our current docket we have 9 issue grievances and 9 just cause grievances.
