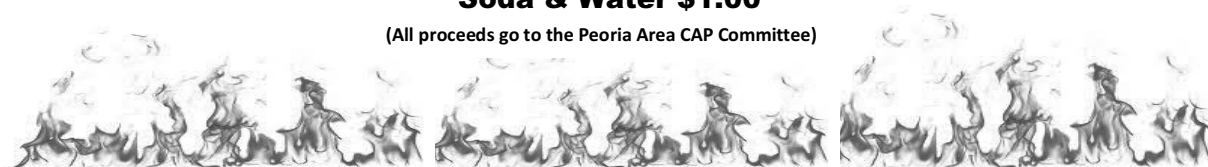

RETIREES - Medicare Reimbursement

From time to time, I remind our retirees about the Medicare Part B reimbursement portion of our plan. If you or your spouse are Medicare age, 65, and enrolled in Medicare Part A & B, you are eligible for reimbursement of the Part B Premium.

The Plan will reimburse your Medicare premium up to \$99.50 per month every January and July. This only pertains to members and spouses that opted out of the management/executive plan and retired prior to March 26, 2017. **You must contact Alight Solutions (Hewitt) at 1-877-228-4010 to enroll for the reimbursement. Once you're signed up, you won't have to sign-up again.**

The General Council, Executive Board and Retirees' Chapter of Local 974 have elected to award fourteen (14) \$500 scholarships from the Heather Henninger Scholarship Fund for the 2019 through 2020 college school year.

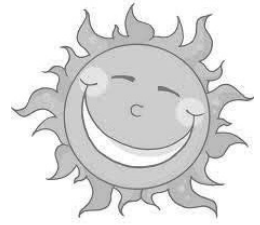

BARGAINING CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

MIKE ATKINSON

Greetings Brother and Sisters,

It looks like things are slowing down in all the business units. Some of the East Peoria facilities early released the first week of July vacation time back to the employees. Then turned around and told them they will not be working the first week of July.

June 5th we had docketing for a Mapleton employee with 25 years seniority with the company. The company discharged the employee for being AWOL. The International pitched a good case for a long term employee with good performance reviews. The company would not budge. So the union held it open for later discussions.

As of July 2, 2019 I have on my docket 32 grievances, 15 issue grievances and 17 just cause grievances.

July 18, 2019 we had a docket meeting with the company for just cause grievances for the East Peoria and Morton facilities for possible arbitration dates of September 17th, 18th and 19th.

I would at this time like to let the membership know that at our last stewards meeting on June 27, 2019. I swore in 11 new stewards. It's really awesome to see the members step up to be a part of this union.

Last week I received a phone call from Brian Brodnick, the new labor rep for building KK, he wanted to discuss insourcing jobs back to the bargaining unit employees. This would involve 30 to 40 jobs that were being done by G&D. It's a line counter labor grade 2 position. He stated that it would primarily keep supplementals from losing their jobs. I will be setting up a meeting with the KK Committee to get the details ironed out.

Well I hope everyone has a great summer, be safe out there.
