
We had the Easter Egg Hunt at the hall on April 13th. Everyone had a good time, but I wish that we could get more of our membership involved.

I want to remind those that are in the management/HRA insurance plan that there are still seminars here every month. Those seminars are put on by Physicians Mutual at 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. on the fourth Tuesday of every month. They will explain how the HRA (Health Reimbursement Account) will work once you turn 65 and are on Medicare.

Retirees mark your calendar for October 10, 2019. There will be a Health Fair at St. Anne's Fellowship from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. They will be doing hearing tests, blood pressure, body composition, nutrition assessments, health screenings, cholesterol and fitness assessments. This is for Union retirees and their spouses all for free.

RETIREES – Medicare Reimbursement

From time to time, I remind our retirees about the Medicare Part B reimbursement portion of our plan. If you or your spouse are Medicare age, 65, and enrolled in Medicare Part A & B, you are eligible for reimbursement of the Part B Premium. **The Plan will reimburse your Medicare premium up to \$99.50 per month every January and July.** This only pertains to members and spouses that opted out of the management/executive plan and retired prior to March 26, 2017. **You must contact Alight Solutions (Hewitt) at 1-877-228-4010 to enroll for the reimbursement. Once you're signed up, you won't have to sign-up again.**

OLD NO. 12

August 2018

In **April 1957**, the township of ELM GROVE, (Tazewell County) decided they need to purchase a new Motor Grader. The old Adams Motor Grader they had was undependable. The decision was made to purchase a **Caterpillar No.12 Motor Grader** from Peoria Tractor & Equipment Company. It was on sale for **\$18,547.50**. The township traded the Adams Grader and gave \$16,500.00 for the new Grader.

One year John Bennet was plowing with it in Rosenberg Acres. A neighbor saw the grader and heard it running, but it was not moving. He went out to investigate and found John unconscious in the cab. He called for help. John had died of a heart attack.

A couple of years later Dick Bennet, John's brother and Elm Groves Highway Commissioner at the time, was plowing snow with the grader when he got stuck not far from the township building. He climbed out of the grader. Walking back to the shop for tire chains, he too had a fatal heart attack.

In addition to road and ditch work, with a V-plow attachment, over the years the grader proved itself very capable of plowing thru Illinois heavy winter snow drifts. It earned its keep plowing on the township's 46 miles of roadways.

In **over 61** years of service the engine has been overhauled, but routine maintenance has been pretty much the norm. Several years ago it developed an oil leak, a failed gasket between the motor and transmission, and a couple of years ago the township had to replace most of the front end, axle and etc. (New parts are not to be found). Used parts were ordered from a supplier. Township employees refer to the grader as **Old No.12**.

New modern plow trucks today perform the snow plowing responsibilites for the Township. However, **Old No.12** is still very useful on Elm Grove's gravel roads, and there's always plenty of ditch work.

Sporting new tires installed in July, **OLD No. 12 stands ready for the task at hand.**



I hope everyone had a nice Easter. I am like everyone else glad this winter is behind us; I am looking forward to spring and summer.

On March 19, 2019 we took a 3 day suspension grievance to arbitration. The grievant was Shane Steveson an East Peoria employee whom the company accused of not using a wooden gauge to align pins and bushings up properly before being pressed together. The day I was preparing this article we received the arbitrator's award. The arbitrator found in favor of Mr. Steveson and the company is to remove the suspension and make him whole.

On March 20, 2019 we had another grievance slated for arbitration for a Morton employee, which a settlement on that grievance was reached. The grievant has decided she no longer desires to work for Caterpillar. She has been taking some classes to complete a degree she was working on while working at Caterpillar and will pursue a different employment opportunity. We hate losing a member but wish her the best and stay in touch.


As of 4/26/19 we have 20 grievances on our docket. 10 Issue grievances and 10 just cause grievances.
