RETIREES - Medicare Reimbursement

From time to time, I remind our retirees about the Medicare Part B reimbursement portion of our plan. If you or your spouse are Medicare age, 65, and enrolled in Medicare Part A & B, you are eligible for reimbursement of the Part B Premium. The Plan will reimburse your Medicare premium up to \$99.50 per month every January and July. This only pertains to members and spouses that opted out of the management/executive plan and retired prior to March 26, 2017. You must contact Alight Solutions (Hewitt) at 1-877-228-4010 to enroll for the reimbursement. Once you're signed up, you won't have to sign-up again.

BARGAINING CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Greetings Brother and Sisters,

I hope everyone is doing well and are trying to stay healthy during these unprecedented times with the COVID-19 virus.

Thank goodness we have not been affected like New York. I think we should all hold a special place in our hearts for all the front-line people, Doctors, Nurses, EMT's and ambulance personnel.

It really did not hit home with me until I was watching the news and saw some people visiting their mother or father in a nursing home and having to stand outside a closed window. It was really sad.

I know a lot of people were upset at the Union for not basically closing Caterpillar down and not having the membership work. What they don't know is the International was in communication with Caterpillar, John Deere and Case New Holland trying to get them to shut down for at least 2 weeks at the onset of this pandemic. That's when the International was informed that due to Homeland Securities Act from 2004 allowed these companies to remain open for business, because they are considered essential businesses. This a Federal rule that overrides any state laws.

Randy Diehl and I have a conference call every Friday at 10:00 a.m. with our International representatives J.C. Zimmerman and Craig Karnes with the Presidents and Chairmen from the other locals in the Caterpillar chain. This has been a great benefit to find out what's going on in the other facilities.

I know at the time that I am writing this report. They are just starting the mandatory mask policy. We will discuss this on Friday, May 2nd's phone call.

We have been instructed to cancel all meeting and events here at the hall until further notice by the International, but the hall is still fully operational and staffed for our members.

Business is really slow for Caterpillar due to the virus. The Mapleton facility ended up laying off the remainder of their supplementals, which a lot of them were picked up by the Morton facility. Mapleton also offered a retirement buyout to I believe 5 people I believe it was well received and a decent deal for the members.

All of the other facilities are also feeling the affects of the downturn in business. So, watch what you are doing because you know they are.

In closing, I wish everyone well, please stay healthy and may God bless you and your family.


