
Greetings Brothers & Sisters,

INSURANCE & BENEFITS REPORT

JOHN ARNOLD -

Well Autumn is here and usually it's my favorite time of the year. But with all that is going on in the world with COVID-19, social distancing and politics, it's hard to enjoy.

Thank you everyone for the cards and condolences on the passing of my mom. She will be missed tremendously by her family.

At the time of writing this article I have not received the 2021 premiums. Most likely even when you are reading this, I still won't have them from Caterpillar. Usually Caterpillar does not give them to the Union until mid to late October. Once I get the premiums I will post them on our website www.uawlocal974.org and the locals Facebook page. I'm hoping to have the premiums the week of October 19th.

I have received calls from a few retirees about a company calling them about a webinar they're having concerning the Caterpillar pensions and 401K's. I called this company to see what they were all about and what they were telling Caterpillar retirees. The representative I talked to was being very evasive on what these webinars were supposed to be about. PLEASE do not fall for these phone calls. They are SCAMS! Your pen-

sion language and calculations are NOT changing and will NOT change.

RETIREES - Medicare Reimbursement

From time to time, I remind our retirees about the Medicare Part B reimbursement portion of our plan. If you or your spouse are Medicare age, 65, and enrolled in Medicare Part A & B, you are eligible for reimbursement of the Part B Premium. **The Plan will reimburse your Medicare premium up to \$99.50 per month every January and July.** This only pertains to members and spouses that opted out of the management/executive plan and retired prior to March 26, 2017. **You must contact Alight Solutions (Hewitt) at 1-877-228-4010 to enroll for the reimbursement. Once you're signed up, you won't have to sign-up again.**

Well we are winding down in the last half of the year, and what a year it has been!! I don't think anyone ever thought they would live to see a year like this in their lifetime. It seems like every month brings new challenges. As we approach the Medicare Open Enrollment season (Oct. 15- Dec. 07) many of you may not be thinking about what changes lay in store with VIA Benefits. Well let's take a moment to look at what has changed and how it might affect you.

On July 1st, VIA once again changed their Reimbursement Forms. The change is a simplification of the current forms making it easier to receive your money back. The bar code and your account number will remain the same as the current forms, and for the foreseeable future they do not expect those to change. The old forms will be phased out of use on December 31ST this year.

They are not automatically sending out the replacement forms for your use. VIA will still send you the Recurring Part B Reimbursement form which will be mailed out in November. The new reimbursement forms will not be available online to print. You will need to contact Via Benefits directly by phone (866) 766-6087 to request the new forms be sent to you.

What this means for retirees on VIA Benefits Reimbursement Program...

1. If you do not file your reimbursement electronically, you will need to order the new form before January 1, 2021

- 2. If you mail your claims in, pay a little extra for a tracking number.
- 3. Make sure you keep original documents. ONLY SEND COPIES.

In short, VIA Benefits is changing their reimbursement system to as much of an electronic experience as possible. This is expected to be fully in place by Jan. 1st 2021.

We have a Potluck the third Wednesday of every month – meat, coffee and doughnuts are furnished. A variety of other activities are planned at various times throughout the year.



Greetings Brother and Sisters,

I hope everyone is doing well during this new lifestyle of COVID-19. While writing this report there has definitely been an uptick in COVID cases in our business units. The Committee from Mapleton has reported to me that they currently have 9 cases in Seals and 3 cases in CMO with around 50 members quarantined.

This office remains busy with many calls pertaining to COVID questions including the company changing their stance on childcare leaves due to daycares beginning to reopen and schools beginning to reopen, as well as how the COVID pay works. Everyone's situation with childcare isn't the same with schools not being open to partial home learning and in class learning. 
